1.	<p>In the Volume 1 – Section 1: Instruction to tenderers, within Technical and professional capacity of candidate on page 10 is defined that tenderer <i>must have completed min. 1 infrastructure project related to construction works and/or reconstruction works and/or rehabilitation works (construction works and/or mechanical works) of hydro facilities of min. value of 1.900.000 EUR</i>, during the last five years from the submission deadline, while on the page 9 is defined that tender must include evidence of relevant experience in carrying out works of a similar nature, including the nature and value of the contracts, works in hand and contractually committed and that the <i>evidence must include successful experience as the prime contractor in construction of at least 3 projects of the same nature and complexity comparable to the works concerned by the tender</i> during the last 5 (five) years.</p> <p>- Does it mean that apart from min. 1 completed infrastructure project related to construction works and/or reconstruction works and/or rehabilitation works (construction works and/or mechanical works) of hydro facilities of min. value of 1.900.000 EUR at least 3 more construction projects of the same nature and complexity comparable to the works concerned by the tender must be completed as well? We presume that an error occurred in the tender documents because it basically means that 4 different projects (references) are required. Please clarify which references are required.</p> <p>- Which period is relevant? 2.	<p>What is the difference between REL weld plate and REL welding angular</p>	<p>The standard SRPS EN ISO 9606-1 separates these two procedures and requires individual qualifications.</p>

3.	3. Is it acceptable for one person (welder) to have both diplomas (REL weld plate and REL welding angular connections)?	It is acceptable that one person (welder) has both diplomas (REL weld plate and REL welding angular connections).
4.	In the Volume 4 two Informative Bills of Quantities are provided (HC Klek and HC Srpski Itebej). On the front page of both documents is stated: "Not to be filled by tenderer". In the Contract form (Volume 2 – Section 2) is defined that Bill of Quantity is the part of the Contract. Do tenderers have to fill out Bills of Quantities and submit them within the tender?	Informative Bills of Quantities are attached in Volume 3 just for tenderer information to be able to define scope of works within lump sum contract.
5.	Considering that in case of consortium the selection criteria is applied to the consortium as a whole, does it mean that only member of consortium which fulfills one particular selection criteria should provide evidence and forms related to that criteria and other members of consortium do not need to. For example, if one member of consortium fulfills economic and financial capacity by itself, do other members of consortium need to provide certified statements of accounts and form 4.4.
