## One potential tenderer asked:

1. We are concerning about our correct meaning of term contract works used in relation with carry out percentage in:

If it is the lead member of a joint venture/consortium it must be able to carry out at least $50 \%$ of the contract works using its own means.

If it is a partner of a joint venture/consortium (i.e. not the lead member) it must be able to carry out at least $10 \%$ of the contract works using its own means.

## Question:

Percentages $50 \%$ and $10 \%$ are applied to total amount of contract (which is $100 \%$ ) or is applied to part contracted work by each member (lead or partner)?

## Banat River Basin Administration reply:

If he is the main partner he has to have $50 \%$ of the contracted part, if he is not the main partner he has to have $10 \%$ of the contracted part.
